I just want to tell you how impressed I've been over time with my 330.

With the skegs, it tracks astonishingly well in wind. It's admirably tough. When I bought it I believed your customer praise, but I somewhat thought of it as a toy boat. It's definitely not! It's a really good boat. Mine's been dragged loaded along rough beaches. It's been shoved repeatedly by the two people inside it (using our paddles) through rock and gravel stretches of shallow rapids. It's performed fine in Class 2 rapids. It's carried large dogs - a German Shepherd and a Rottweiler - without any damage from their nails. It's so stable that when my Rottweiler charged at the first speed limit buoy he'd ever seen, he flipped into the water but the boat stayed upright. (He made friends with the buoy).

As for maneuverability, last fall I tried out an expensive (Aire) inflatable and was surprised to find that I wouldn't trade it for my Sea Eagle! By comparison, it was like trying to maneuver a log.

The boat has earned my respect completely. I've come to think of it as extremely dependable, and I love it. I've had quite seasoned people eye it with respect on docks.
